Investment Objective

The investment objective of the Fund is to provide a total return for investors through a combination of income and long-term capital growth.

The Fund is actively managed without reference to a benchmark or comparative index for performance comparison purposes.

Investment Approach

A global dynamic bond approach: active allocation across government bonds, investment grade credit and selective higher-yielding opportunities, built around three core ideas:

High income generation: attractive monthly income, paid gross on distributing share classes, providing a meaningful foundation for total returns.

Active credit selection: a valuation-led approach, to identify undervalued bonds in combination with fundamental credit analysis, where a clear catalyst aims to close the gap to fair value.

Macro flexibility: dynamic macro overlay enables management of duration, government bonds, credit and FX exposure through a structured framework of fundamental, positioning and technical inputs.

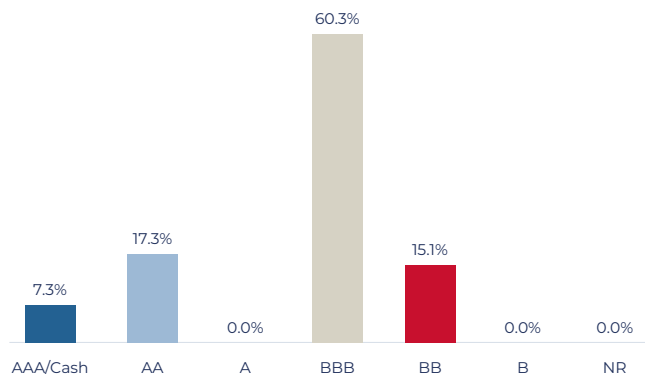

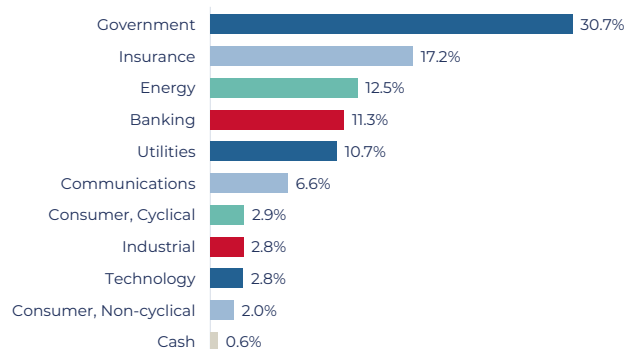
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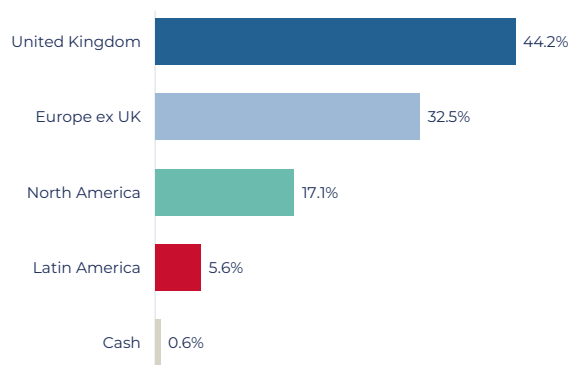
Credit Quality



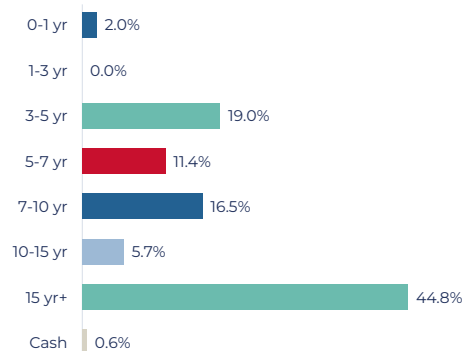
Sector Exposure
